

Oxford Referencing Guide

In-Text Citation:

For a direct quotation: (Author's Last Name, Year of Publication, Page Number)

Example: (Smith, 2019, p. 45)

For paraphrasing or a general reference: (Author's Last Name, Year of Publication)

Example: (Smith, 2019)

Bibliography Entry:

Book with a single author:

Format: Author's Last Name, Author's First Name. Title of the Book. Publisher, Year of Publication.

Example: Smith, John. The Art of Referencing. Oxford University Press, 2019.

Book with multiple authors (up to three):

Format: Author's Last Name, Author's First Name, and Author's First Name Last Name. Title of the Book. Publisher, Year of Publication.

Example: Johnson, Alice, and Smith, John. Citing with Precision. Oxford University Press, 2020.

Book with more than three authors:

Format: Author's Last Name, Author's First Name, et al. Title of the Book. Publisher, Year of Publication.

Example: Harris, Robert, et al. Advanced Referencing Techniques. Academic Publications, 2018.
