Write multiple sections with clear headings, and provide evidence, analysis, and citations to support your arguments.

Conclude your essay by summarizing your findings and discussing their implications.

In-text Citations: Use APA style in-text citations to reference sources in your essay.

References: List all the sources you cited in your essay on a separate page, following the APA format for references.

Remember, for college application essays, you should use the Common App or the specific format requested by the college you're applying to. APA format is more appropriate for academic essays and research papers.
